



Connecting to PerunaNet—the Secure Wireless Network

Secured wireless networking is available throughout campus including all Residence Halls and in the common areas of most Fraternity houses.

Mac OS 10.5 (Leopard)

1. Click **Apple** menu
2. Select **System Preferences**
3. Select **Network**
4. Select **Edit locations** (from the location drop down menu)
5. Click the **Plus** sign to add a new location
6. Enter **SMU** as the location name
7. Click **Done**
8. The new location should be selected by default. Click the **Airport link** on the left
9. Click the Arrow next to **Network Name**
10. Select **Join Other Network**
11. Enter **PerunaNet** as the network name
12. Select **WPA Enterprise** as the Security type
13. Enter your **SMU ID** number as the username
14. Enter your **SMU password**
15. Click **Join**
16. A certificate should appear asking for your acceptance. Click **Continue**.
17. Click the **Advanced** button
18. Click the **TCP/IP** tab
19. Click the **Configure IPv6** button and select **Off**
20. Click **Apply**



Troubleshooting Wireless Connectivity Issues

1. Verify that the Date and Time are correct on your computer.
2. Clear all passwords and certificates saved in your keychain
 - a. Launch the Finder
 - b. Select Applications—Utilities—Keychain Access
 - c. Delete any reference to PerunaNet, s31rad.systems.smu.edu, and s32rad.systems.smu.edu
3. Turn Off the airport card and then turn it back it again
 - a. Click the Airport icon in the top right hand corner of your screen
 - b. Select Turn AirPort Off
 - c. Select Turn Air Port On
 - d. Select PerunaNet from the list of available networks
