Physics 3368 Astrophysics and Cosmology Paper Guidelines

(Revised 04/15/2015)

- 1. The paper should be 3000 words in length using either 10 pt or 12 pt font with 1.5 spacing between lines.
- 2. You are required to have at least 1 figure or table relevant to your topic, explained with a caption. Figure size should be 3"x 5" (max). Any font contained in the figure must be of minimum height 2 mm. Color figures are fine, but not required.
- 3. You must include bibliography and title page which do not count towards the paper length. The citations in the bibliography should follow the Chicago Manual of Style (http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools-citationguide.html).
- 4. Paper margins should be 1" on the top, bottom, left and right hand sides of the paper.
- 5. The audience for you paper is that of the level appropriate for a 3000 level class. Assume the audience has no expertise in your topic.
- 6. Plagiarism will not be tolerated. Any student who plagiarizes material will be dealt with in accordance to university policy outlined on page 32 of the 2014-2015 Student Handbook.
- 7. Appointment can be made to review paper topics with me outside of class.
- 8. The paper will be due at 6 pm on Wednesday, April 15th. If you are not happy with the grade you receive, you will have a chance to re-write the paper. The final paper will be due on the last day of instruction, at 6 pm Monday, May 4th. In order to qualify for a re-write, you must turn in a complete, finished paper at 6 pm on Wednesday, April 15th.
- 9. I recommend that you take advantage of the writing center at SMU (http://smu.edu/alec/wc.asp) if you need help with any stage of your writing.
- 10. You are required to submit a both a hard copy and a pdf electronic version by the required due date and time. The electronic version should be submitted via email to cooley@physics.smu.edu.
