In an effort to keep the cost of your introductory physics textbooks to a minimum and your learning experience to a maximum, the physics department has worked with our textbook publisher to offer you online access to your textbook, the student solution manual and several learning online learning tools such as brief videos and tutorials through WileyPLUS. Before you purchase your textbooks, we would like to make sure you are aware of your options.

- 1. You can purchase WileyPLUS online only. This is the most economical option. You will have full access to the online version of the textbook. You will be able to print pages from the text in the case that you want to read the book, but do not have internet access. In addition, you will have access to all the student solution manual, study aids and for some courses the homework assignments. Please note that this access lasts for the lifetime of the edition and includes online access to both the Introductory Mechanics and the Introductory Electricity and Magnetism textbook.
- 2. You can purchase a new printed text in the bookstore with a WileyPLUS online access code. This will cost \$5 \$20 more than purchasing WileyPLUS online access alone for the first semester book. The second semester book can also be purchased in the book store and will cost significantly more than the first semester book. However, if you take the second semester course next semester, you may find another vendor who will offer a cheaper price for the second semester textbook. This option will cost more than option 1.
- 3. You can purchase a used version of the textbook from a vendor of your choosing. Be warned, some faculty use the WileyPLUS online homework system. If this is the case, you will still need to purchase WileyPLUS online. In some cases, this will cost more than option 2.
