The registration is on the CERN Indico system, and is linked from the main webpage. Payment of the registration fees is **separate**; this can be done by credit card (link on webpage) by check (info on webpage), or by wire transfer (contact us directly).

**ABSTRACTS:**

The final abstract deadline is 15 March. The conveners have been hard at work organizing the sessions and have begun to send out acceptances already; this process will be completed shortly, but if you have questions you may contact the conveners directly. **HOTEL INFORMATION:**

The suggested conference hotel is the **Holiday Inn Dallas Central—Park Cities**. The conference rate is \$95/night+tax, and includes breakfast and Wi-Fi. We suggest you reserve your room sooner rather than later as other hotels in the area are more expensive.

**SHARED ROOM OPTION:** We will organize shared rooms with other DIS participants; the hard deadline is **21 March** as we must provide the information to the hotel in advance.

**TRAVEL INFORMATION:**

**AIRPORTS:** Dallas is served by two major airports. **Dallas-Fort Worth (DFW)** is the large international airport. **Dallas Love Field (DAL)** is the smaller airport. SMU is easily accessible from both these airports by bus, train, and taxi. Note that **Southwest Airlines** now flies direct from Dallas to many major US cities at reasonable fares<sup>1</sup>.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Detailed travel information will be posted on the website as we get closer. The Holiday Inn Hotel is accessible from both airports by public transport (as well as multiple shuttle services), and the meeting venue is walking distance from the hotel. Rental cars are NOT necessary and probably not useful (parking on campus is limited).
