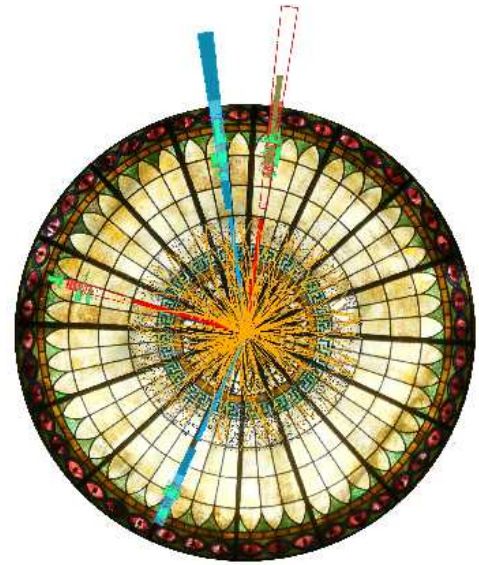

TRAVEL INFORMATION:

AIRPORTS: Dallas is served by two major airports. **Dallas-Fort Worth (DFW)** is the large international airport. **Dallas Love Field (DAL)** is the smaller airport. SMU is easily accessible from both these airports by bus, train, and taxi. Note that **Southwest Airlines** now flies direct from Dallas to many major US cities at reasonable fares¹.

TRANSPORTATION: Detailed travel information will be posted shortly on the website. The Holiday Inn Hotel is accessible from both airports by public transport (as well as multiple shuttle services), and the meeting venue is walking distance from the hotel.

Rental cars are NOT necessary and probably not useful (parking on campus is limited).
