PRIZE INFORMATION SHEET**

IMPORTANT!!

Thank you for agreeing to be a Special Award donor! The following options are offered to expedite the gathering and personalization of awards, the disbursements of prize money, and the collection of banquet money.

1. **You may send your prize money payable to the Dallas Regional Science Fair (or DRSF)** and we will then generate the check for the award winner. This check will be issued to the winner at the banquet with all the other special and general Science Fair awards. Only one award will be represented on each check.
2. If your prize contains a certificate that you wish to have personalized, we can do this for you free of charge. If your prize contains a plaque that you wish to have personalized (engraving), we can have this done for you for a fee of \$5 per plaque (engraving of name only).
3. If your prize is a savings bond, we can contact you promptly after the Fair with the name, address and social security number of your winner, or we can process the bond for your winner(s) for you.
4. Banquet sponsorship money is paid as follows: **for each award given (except for Honorable Mentions, who do not attend the Awards Banquet), the Special Award donor sends \$30 to pay for both the student and his/her teacher to attend the Awards Banquet.** If you select a group project as your winner, you will NOT be charged an additional fee for the additional student(s).
5. All prize, personalization and banquet money can be sent on one check, payable to the DRSF.

Hopefully this information will make coordination and delivery of your Special Awards easier.

Please remember award winners are NOT to know that they have won a prize until the formal announcement on Sunday, March 25th, 2007. This is to protect the students, their families and their teachers from potentially hurtful misinformation.
