GATE #4: PROJECT DROP-OFF: Intersection of Parry Ave. and First St.

Permit/Handicap Parking. **No general parking.**

GATE #5 & #6 RECOMMEND PARKING: Grand & MLK Ave. entrances.

This is in front of the Science Place.

GATE #3: UNKNOWN PARKING: Intersection of Parry & Washington Ave.

Parking availability at this location is subject to other events.

Enter the Automobile Building through the south (main) entrance. Pick up registration packets and exhibit assignments upon arrival.

9:00 a.m.-NoonRound One of Judging - Interviews

All exhibitors will be interviewed by judges. Exhibitors are required to stay with their projects during this time. Note: Interviews are an important part of the evaluation process. Students not present for the interview are NOT eligible to win a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd Fair Award.

Noon (approximately)

All students are dismissed. Science Projects may not be removed. All students are required to exit the hall.

Noon-12:30 p.m.

Round One of Judging is completed. Only judges and officials may remain in the Automobile Building.

1:00-3:00 p.m.Round Two of Judging

All prize winners will be determined by the end of this Round.

3:30-4:00 p.m.First-place Winners Posted

All First-place winners will be called and asked to return to the Automobile Building for Final Round judging. The names of all First-place winners will be posted on the doors at the front entrance to the hall and at www.DallasScienceFair.org. It is imperative that students are reachable by phone or present outside the Automobile Building during this time.

4:00-6:30 p.m. (approximately) . . . Final Round of Judging

First-place winners must return to the Automobile Building and remain during the Final Round of Judging in order to qualify for a Grand Prize. The Final Round Judges will be selecting four Grand Prize winners from the Junior Division and four Grand Prize winners from the Senior Division.

Noon-4:00 p.m.

Science Fair is open to the public.

No exhibits may be removed until 4:00p.m. on Sunday! Failure to comply with this rule will result in penalties for your school.

3:00 p.m.

State Science Fair Meeting.

4:00-5:00 p.m.

All exhibits are removed. A Removal Pass is required and will be provided in your registration packet when you check in on Saturday. Please make arrangements (i.e. with a classmate or teacher) if you cannot be present between 4:00 and 5:00 p.m. on Sunday to remove your project. It is important that the person removing your project has the Removal Pass.

Please Note:

- Tables and chairs will be provided. It is essential that students bring all other supplies necessary for their exhibit, including 25 ft., 16 gauge, **grounded** extension cords, batteries, tape, scissors, staplers, etc..
- Refer to Science Fair Rules at www.DallasScienceFair.org for size limitations and all Rules and Safety Procedures. **Any exhibit that is in violation of these rules will be disqualified.**
